Biogas as peace keeper

A Thai poultry farmer had a choice. Either close his farm or restore the friendship with his neighbours. Wisely he chose for the last. The manure of his hens caused heavy problems with odour and flies for the neighbouring villagers. By installing a bio-digester, he prevented the closure of his farm.
